It can be difficult to know which can opener, or which magnifier, will be most suited to your needs, so we encourage you to look on-line for alternatives to the ones we have listed.

The price listed is an average price, either within one source or across two or more. When items have a wide range of pricing, we show that as "\$12-\$25". We researched a number of vendors. When possible, we encourage you to make your purchases from local pharmacies and neighborhood stores.
